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HAIR AND MAKEUP

Please have the performer's hair and make up finished before arriving, according to instructions given on page 7. Give yourself at least 1 hour to prepare their hair and make up before the show. If you feel like you cannot do this, ask a friend, another class members' parent, your neighbor or a family member to help you. We cannot help you with this on the show day for timing reasons.

1. Extra hairpins, hair gel/spray (just in case hair gets messy when putting on costume)
2. Ballet shoes (make sure to write name on them)
3. Ballet tights

REHEARSAL LESSON

Théâtre de Marens Rte du Stand 5, 1260 Nyon

Arrive at "**students arrival time**". Enter the theater from the side that faces the Hospital. The main entrance doors will be locked for security reasons. Take the stairs down and follow the signs. For space reasons, please only ONE parent in the dressing area with each student. Please help your child dress for the rehearsal and recitals. For rehearsal please stay in the dressing area until a teacher or class volunteer moves the children to the stage area. At this time you are welcome to enter the theater and take photos and videos of the rehearsal. After the dancers are finished on stage they will return to the dressing area, please meet them below and help remove the costume. You are finished for the day! Rehearsal lesson is approximately 1 hour per dance.

ACT 1 PERFORMERS

Arrive one hour before the show time. Find your costumes and get dressed, one parent in the changing area per dancer. Go into the larger room to make space for others to change. Here is a good place for parents to take photos inside and outside. About 15 minutes before the show time the dancers will line up backstage with the help of the teachers and class volunteers. At the end of Act 1 the dancers will return to the large room. Parents must pick up their child. They are welcome to stay in costume or change. They then can watch Act 2 in the theater with their family. Dancers do not need to purchase a ticket. Please be sure to return costumes after the show.

ACT 2 PERFORMERS

Arrive one hour before the show time. Find your costumes and get dressed, one parent in the changing area per dancer. Go into the larger room to make space for others to change. Here is a good place for parents to take photos inside and outside. About 15 minutes before the start of the show they will be taken into the theater to watch Act 1. At intermission they will then return downstairs and prepare backstage for Act 2. At the end of the show parents are invited onto the stage to collect their dancers. This is a time when all dancers and parents are invited onto the stage to take photos. Please be sure to return costumes after the show.

VOLUNTEERING

We need 1-2 parents per class to help with check in and putting on costumes, and supervision of dancers. If you would like to help out in your child's class, or with another class, please fill out the google form. Helpers arrive 15 minutes before the students' arrival time and leave when all the students in the class have returned to their parents (max 1h30m total). More details are on the google form.

REGULAR CLASSES DURING SHOW WEEKS

There will be **NO regular classes during the week between the Rehearsal/Recital weekends, June 3rd-7th, 2024**. Your Rehearsal lesson will replace the normal class that week. The week after the last performance, classes continue normally until the end of the dance school year.

Last day of classes: Sunday June 16th, 2024.

AUDIENCE MEMBERS

Please do not use flash photography. You are welcome to video and take pictures of the performance. You will receive a link to the professional videos of each show approximately 1 month after the finish of all the shows.

COSTUMES

The show fee is to cover some of the cost of washing, wear and tear, costume steaming, size adjustment etc. Costumes are provided by us and stay with us.

You do NOT need to bring your classroom uniform. Just pink tights and ballet shoes

Modern & Diamonds will need tan footless tights, available in the ballet shop.

MAKEUP

We do **not** require full stage makeup, but it is highly recommended. We have a full stage makeup tutorial video for you below.

Lipstick color should be a natural pink-reddish direction (blush) and 1-2 shades darker than the lips. **The make up tutorial part starts at 3:23 in the video**

WHERE CAN I BUY SUPPLIES?

BALLET TIGHTS & SHOES

All performers must have pink ballet tights and real ballet shoes (not H&M etc). If you do not have ballet tights or shoes, please make sure to buy some before arriving at the theater. We have supplies at our ballet shop at the school. You can now pay for ballet shop items by twint! Please check that your tights do not have any holes or make-up stains.
