GENERAL NOTES

- Uniforms are obligatory every week.
- Ballet shoes are required for all levels.
- **Label all items** with your child's name.
- X No jewelry (except small earrings). Please remove armbands, necklaces, etc., before class.
- Water bottle: Only water is allowed in the classroom. No food or other drinks in the studio.



🥻 BALLET UNIFORM

Opal (Age 4+)

- Any color and style of **dancewear** (not costumes)
- Attached skirt preferred
- Pink ballet shoes (leather, no laces not from H&M or similar)
- Hair pulled back from the face

Pearl

- Pink leotard with attached skirt
- Pink ballet shoes (leather, no laces not from H&M or similar)
- Hair pulled back from the face

All Other Levels

- Black leotard, with or without skirt or shorts
- Pink ballet tights
- Pink ballet shoes (leather, no laces not from H&M or similar)
- Hair in a ballet bun

Boys (All Levels)

White top, black bottoms (leggings or shorts)

Black or white ballet shoes



CONTEMPORARY UNIFORM

- Black leotard with or without skirt, shorts, or leggings
- Must be well-fitting dancewear (not loose or casual clothing)
- Tan footless tights
- Contemporary shoes
- Hair pulled back from the face

💁 HAIR FOR BALLET
